

**MINUTES of the CCR 2017 S2-7.9m CLASS MEETING  
HOLLAND, MI. SEPTEMBER 23, 2017**



1. 28 boat owners present or represented.
2. Welcome and thank you to M. Kiss and MBYC for hosting the 2017 CCR.
3. Thank you and compliments to Racine Yacht Club for hosting the 2016 CCR.
4. The minutes of the 2016 CCR meeting were approved (posted on web).
5. The financial summary 2016-2017 (posted on web). Current bank balance = \$23,829
6. Old business:
  - A. Letter documentation that mast extrusion die by Extrudex still stored in useable condition.
  - B. Letter from Island Nautical (St. Petersburg); count 25 mast blanks.
7. New business:
  - A. One mast blank sold in the past twelve months; no spreaders.
  - B. Dues: the majority vote supported no change from current \$30/yr dues.
  - C. 2018 CCR at Grosse Isle on Lake Erie to be hosted by the Ford Yacht Club. Member and organizer Cary Diehl provided an introduction. The dates will be September 7, 8, 9, 2018. Of interest, there will likely be a classic-car show on those dates.
  - D. Ford Yacht Club will again host a spring regatta on June. There is no known plan to change the 2018 Equalizer event in Nashville.
  - D. Rudder replacement issue (discussion by Cary Diehl). The final decision regarding replacement manufacture will be decided by the class directors.
  - E. The 2019 CCR location is Racine, WI hosted by the Racine Yacht Club.
  - F. A majority vote supported allowing the hull number to be required on the main sail only, and elective on other sails.
